

Exciting International Opportunity for Advanced Practitioners: Expression of Interest

Homelessness Australia (HA) is seeking expressions of interest from Advanced Practitioners to be part of the Housing First Europe Train-the-Trainer project. The project is a partnership with the Housing First Europe Hub, which has the strategic aim of promoting and supporting the implementation of Housing First in Europe and beyond.

This project aims to expand the Australian Specialist Homelessness Sector's (SHS) capability in delivering Housing First programs. It will strengthen our SHS capacity to deliver Housing First programs, as the evidence based response that ends homelessness for most people who have experienced long-term homelessness and have high or complex needs. HA is looking to partner with organisations that:

- Are committed to Housing First programs
- Have a strong track record of Housing First program delivery and
- Have an outstanding, passionate Housing First practitioner who can also commit to the project.

The project involves:

- Trips (3 or 4) to Europe over approx. 12 months, to undertake the Housing First Europe Train-the-Trainer program
- The Advanced Practitioners working together to develop and deliver Housing First training for Australia
- Participating in the Housing First Europe Hub Community of Practice
- Working together to support Housing First trainers in Australia.

Homelessness Australia intends this Expression of Interest (EOI) process to identify two outstanding practitioners, working in enthusiastic and supportive services, who will be trained, and provide training to practitioners from across Australia. The EOI endeavours to make clear the expectations and commitment required of individual participants and their employers.

Organisations will need to be prepared to release their participating staff member on full pay to participate in the project. Travel and accommodation costs will be funded through generous support from the Melbourne based Lord Mayor's Charitable Foundation (LMCF).
